

**Project Title:** South Bay Bicycle Mini-Corral Plan


**Location:** South Bay, Los Angeles County

The planning project will develop a plan that identifies the most appropriate places to install bicycle mini-corrals throughout the cities of Hermosa Beach, Manhattan Beach, and Redondo Beach.

### Goals

- Identify ideal locations for mini bike corrals
- Provide ample and convenient bicycle planning
- Encourage bicycling over driving to reduce GHG emissions

The South Bay Bicycle Mini-Corral Plan recommends locations and provides bicycle design guidelines for bicycle mini-corrals in the cities of Hermosa Beach, Manhattan Beach, and Redondo Beach. The Plan implements the bicycle parking recommendations from the previously completed South Bay Bicycle Maser Plan. Using online and in-person community input, the project team developed recommendations for five prioritized locations for bicycle mini-corrals per city, totaling fifteen. Detailed recommendations for each site were developed including a site description and rationale, concept graphic, parking capacity, estimated costs, and site images.

### Results

- Community-based teams conducted field visits at 21 locations for potential priority bicycle mini-corral sites, resulting in 15 priority locations.

- Nine secondary priority locations were also identified (three secondary priority locations per city)
- Identified six funding sources that can be used to purchase and install bicycle mini-corrals.
- Implementation of the plan would result in over 100 new bicycle parking locations without removing any automobile parking spaces.
