BOYLE HEIGHTS LIVING STREETS

City of Los Angeles

Reduce greenhouse gas emissions and carbon footprint through installation of street improvements near three light rail stations in East Los Angeles to increase bike and pedestrian activity.

The GreenLA Coalition, Community Redevelopment Agency, and LA Bicycle Coalition received a \$240,000 grant from the Department of Public Health to improve public health by developing street improvements to encourage pedestrian and bicycle activity and reduce greenhouse gas emissions. The projects include: traffic calming, enhanced crosswalks, sidewalks, signage and lighting and low-impact landscaping.

This Living Streets Initiative is part of a \$25 million city effort to design and install street improvements near Gold Line Stations in the Boyle Heights neighborhood.
